We Can See It In Their Eyes!

The Bible mentions this slow death : "...*She who lives in pleasure is dead while she lives.*" 1Timothy 5:6, and "...*The wages of sin is death...*" Romans 6:23.

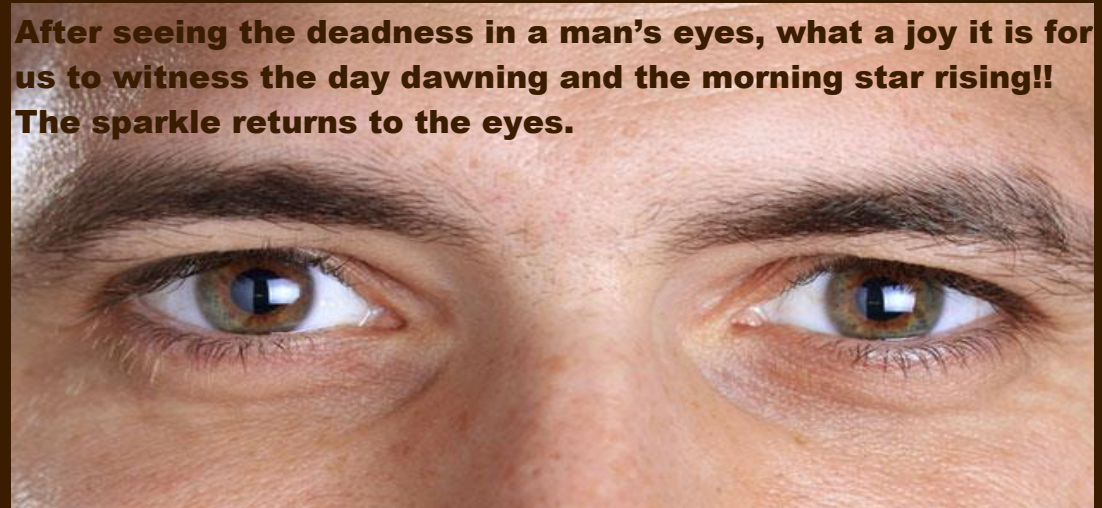
Have you heard the saying, 'The eyes are the windows to the soul?' I don't know about this, but I am able to see the deadness in a man's eyes, when he first arrives!

Matthew 6:22 seems to connect spirituality to the eyes: "*The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.*"

Second Peter 1:19 is one of the most beautiful passages in the Bible: "*And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.*" The "*light that shines in a dark place*" refers to the Gospel of Christ shining into this dark world of sin. "*Until the day dawns*" is the dawning of the light in the hearts of the redeemed, a dawning which took place initially in their conversion, but which is envisioned here as a continuing phenomenon of their lives in Christ. "*The morning star rises in your heart*" is a reference to the light given to Christians through their taking "*heed*" to the sure Word of God. (Burton Coffman adapted)

The time between a man's arrival at Project Rescue and two months of Bible classes, worship services and fellowship, creates great change. The Apostle Paul described this process as: "And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins..."
